Use other items you might find in your house like: magazines, paper clips, elastics, art supplies, other scraps you may find. Use your imagination. It is time for your child to practice these self-help skills to be sure they are more independent for first grade. Please practice:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Zippering, buttoning, snapping clothing</li> <li>Fixing inside-out sleeves</li> <li>Tying shoes</li> </ul> 	<p><b>Handwashing</b></p> <p>Visit <a href="http://www.youtube.com">www.youtube.com</a> and search for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Sid the Science Kid – “Germ’s”.</li> <li>Jack Hartmann – “Wash My Hands”</li> </ul> <p>Then practice proper handwashing.</p>

Find items that begin with each letter of the alphabet.</p> <p><b>Challenge:</b> Try sounding out each of those words and writing them down.</p> 	<p><b>Make a Match!</b></p> <p>Have a grown up write an uppercase letter and you will write the lowercase letter. When you are finished, switch jobs!</p> 	<p><b>Kindness Counts</b></p> <p>Write a sentence or two about how you were kind today. Draw a picture to illustrate.</p>
